Summary: WVSOM is seeking a full-time tenure track Internal Medicine Faculty Member. Candidates should be residency trained and Board Certified or Board Eligible in Internal Medicine. Ideally the successful candidate will have clinical and teaching experience. The successful candidate must also be eligible for licensure in the State of West Virginia.

Responsibilities: Primary responsibilities include providing pre and post doctoral education and training to WVSOM students, interns and residents, plus all attendant educational activities, which may include lecturing, assisting with physical diagnosis, physician skills labs and ACLS instruction. It is expected that the successful candidate will spend 60-80% of their time providing clinical care with the majority being hospital based care. Research is supported and encouraged but not required.
